In the book of Galatians 1:6-9, the Apostle Paul warns against the preaching of "Another Gospel"
What is another Gospel?

Another Gospel is that which adds to, or takes from, the free, sovereign grace of God.

Another Gospel, in actuality, says that man is not truly spiritually dead in trespasses and sin. For another Gospel teaches that he has a free will whereby he may or may not respond to God's overtures to be saved from sin's power and penalty.
